## RECEIVER'S MONTHLY REPORT BUENA VISTA WATER SYSTEM BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS For the Month Ending January 31, 2011

COMES NOW, JOHN M. FULTZ, duly appointed Receiver for Buena Vista Water System (the "Water System"), and files this Receiver's Monthly Report for the month ending January 31, 2011, and would show this Court the following:

- 1. John M. Fultz was appointed Receiver of the Water System by Receivership Order signed by this Court on July 8, 2010 (the "Order").
- 2. The Water System is alleged to be owned by Kathie Bryant, individually, d/b/a Buena Vista Water System.
- The Order authorized the Receiver to take possession and control of the Water System located in Burnet County, Texas.
- 4. Receiver employed Gulf Utility Service, Inc., (the "Operator"), on July 12, 2010. The Operating Agreement between the Receiver and Gulf Utility Service, Inc. is available and on file in the Receiver's office. The Operator's license and resume of Terry Taylor, President, is available and on file in the Receiver's office.
- 5. The Receiver operates the Water System through the Operator. The Operator has maintained the Water System, performed monthly maintenance of the Water System, filed the appropriate monthly water reports, read the meters, billed the customers, collected and deposited the funds received in payment, and prepared checks for payment of the monthly bills and returned the same to the Receiver.
- 6. The Receiver reviewed the Operator's Buena Vista Water System's Systems Totals Report, Profit & Loss Report, Balance Sheet and A/P Aging Detail for January 2010, copies of which are attached.

- 7. During the month of January, the Receiver continued to maintain communication via email and telephone with Michael Wortham, President of the Buena Vista Property Owners Association.
- 8. Terry Taylor of Gulf Utility Service, Inc., made personal visits to the water plant and facilities to oversee employees and operations.
- 9. The Receiver confirmed through the Operator that the plant at the Water System was running well.
- 10. The Receiver took the following actions during the month of January 2011:
  - a. On January 3, 2011, the Receiver reviewed two quotes provided to the Operator to install the communication device between the water plant and the water tanks in the Water System. The Receiver and the Operator will implement the changes in the near future.
  - b. The January 5, 2011, the Receiver and the Operator reviewed the estimates of the initial cost analysis submitted on December 20, 2010, to Terry Webb, TCEQ Receivership Coordinator, for review and consideration. The Receiver is reevaluating the expenses, consulting with the Operator and will resubmit the figures to TCEQ before proceeding to request approval of a temporary rate Increase for the customers in the Water System for the proposed temporary rate increase.
  - c. On January 11, 2011, the Receiver followed up with Jennifer Frithiof, Accounts Manager with Texas Department of Health Services "DSHS", requesting that Analysis Reports be provided to the Receiver in accordance with the October 21, 2010, agreement between the Receiver and DSHS for repayment of delinquent fees incurred by the owner of the Water System prior to the appointment of the Receiver. The DSHS will release the Analysis Reports monthly upon special request by Receiver until the entire delinquent balance is paid in full.
  - d. On January 12, 2011, the Receiver reviewed correspondence dated January 3, 2011, from TCEQ regarding the Cross-Connection Control Questionnaire. The Receiver forwarded the correspondence and questionnaire to the Operator.
  - e. On January 13, 2011, the Receiver reviewed invoices from Kathie Bryant forwarded to the Receiver for payment. The Receiver prepared correspondence to Nancy Donnelley, Kathie Bryant's bookkeeper, acknowledging receipt of the invoices. The Receiver forwarded correspondence to Keith Kebodeaux, attorney for Kathie Bryant, explaining that the Receiver would not make payment for expenses incurred prior to the inception of the receivership.

- f. On January 17, 2011, the Receiver forwarded payment in the amount of \$727.22 to Burnet County Tax Assessor for 2010 taxes on the personal property and property taxes of the Water System.
- g. On or about January 21, 2011, the Receiver reviewed correspondence dated January 15, 2011, from TCEQ regarding the 2010 Water Loss Audit Report. The Receiver forwarded the correspondence to the Operator for action on or before March 31, 2011.
- h. On or about January 24, 2011, the Receiver reviewed correspondence dated January 20, 2011, from TCEQ regarding the Filter Backwash Recycling Rule. The Receiver forwarded the correspondence to the Operator.
- On or about January 31, 2011, the Receiver received a copy of the Class B Surface Water Treatment Operator License for Alan Burdell. The license is maintained in the file of the Receiver and the Operator.
- 11. The Receiver and the Operator have reviewed and evaluated the condition of the System and assessed the financial requirements of the Water System to provide the continuous and adequate supply of water to the customers of the Water System.
- 12. The Receiver continues to make monthly payments on the delinquent amounts owed to the Department of State Health Service, Central Lab Services (DSHS) for lab fees incurred prior to the appointment of the Receiver. The Receiver has an agreement with DSHS to make payment in full by April 2011.
- 13. The Receiver will continue to operate the System through the Operator.

This concludes the Receiver's Monthly Report for the month ending January 31, 2011.
