RECEIVER'S MONTHLY REPORT BUENA VISTA WATER SYSTEM BURNET COUNTY, TEXAS For the Month Ending September 30, 2011

COMES NOW, JOHN M. FULTZ, duly appointed Receiver for Buena Vista Water System (the "Water System"), and files this Receiver's Monthly Report for the month ending September 30, 2011, and would show this Court the following:

- 1. John M. Fultz was appointed Receiver of the Water System by Receivership Order signed by this Court on July 8, 2010 (the "Order").
- 2. The Water System is alleged to be owned by Kathie Bryant, individually, d/b/a Buena Vista Water System.
- 3. The Order authorized the Receiver to take possession and control of the Water System located in Burnet County, Texas.
- 4. The Receiver employed Gulf Utility Service, Inc., (the "Operator"), on July 12, 2010. The Operating Agreement between the Receiver and Gulf Utility Service, Inc. is available and on file in the Receiver's office. The resume and operator's license are available and on file in the Receiver's office.
- 5. The Receiver operates the Water System through the Operator. The Operator has maintained the Water System, performed monthly maintenance of the Water System, filed the appropriate monthly water reports, read the meters, billed the customers, collected and deposited the funds received in payment, and prepared checks for payment of the monthly bills and returned the same to the Receiver for review and payment to the appropriate vendors.

- 6. The Receiver reviewed the Operator's Buena Vista Water System's Systems Totals Report, Profit & Loss Report, Balance Sheet and A/P Aging Detail for September 2011, copies of which are attached.
- 7. The Receiver confirmed through the Operator that the plant at the Water System was running well and that repairs continue to be made on an as needed basis to provide the continuous and adequate supply of water to the customers of the Water System.
- 8. The Receiver took the following actions during the month of September, 2011:
 - a. On September 1, 2011, the Receiver through the Operator, forwarded to all customers of the Hazy Hills Water System the Mandatory Stage III Water Use Restrictions Notice, a copy of which is attached hereto.
 - b. On September 2, 2011, the Receiver reviewed the Analysis Report for the following: All Metals, Volatile Organic Compounds by GC/MS, Haloacetic Acids, and Trihalomethanes by GC/MS. All lab results were acceptable for the samples submitted in the month of August, 2011. The results were forwarded to the Operator.
 - c. On September 14, 2011, the Receiver forwarded to the insurance agency an updated list of assets of the Buena Vista Water System to be insured.
 - d. On September 20, 2011, the Receiver reviewed correspondence dated September 9, 2011, from TCEQ regarding Notice of Violation for Total Haloacetic Acids for the 1st Quarter of 2011 and for the 2nd Quarter of 2011. The Notices were forwarded to the Operator with instructions to provide public notification using mandatory language to all customers of the Buena Vista Water System by October 9, 2011. The Receiver directed that proper parties at TCEQ be provided Notice and that the required Certificate of Delivery of Public Notice to Customers be provided timely.
 - e. On September 20, 2011, the Receiver conferred with Tracy Killebrew, the daughter and attorney-in-fact of Kathie Bryant. The Receiver was advised that Mrs. Killebrew would be acting under the Power of Attorney signed by Kathie Bryant. The Receiver requested a copy of the Power of Attorney before discussing specifics of the Water System with Mrs. Killebrew.
 - f. On or about September 22, 2011, the Receiver conferred with Tom Bohl, the Assistant Attorney General, regarding the telephone conversation with Tracy Killebrew, the daughter and attorney-in-fact of Kathie Bryant. A status of the financial position of the Water System was also discussed.

- 9. The Operator performed the tasks shown on the attached work orders for the reporting month.
- 10. The Receiver will continue to operate the System through the Operator.

This concludes the Receiver's Monthly Report for the month ending September 30, 2011.

MANDATORY Stage III Water Use Restrictions Notice

As stated on Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) drought update page, http://www.lcra.org/water/drought/index.html.

Texas and the lower Colorado River basin remain in severe drought as the region's oppressive hot and dry weather is showing no signs of letting up. The 10 months from October 2010 through July 2011 have been the driest for that 10-month period in Texas since 1895, when the state began keeping rainfall records. That record is likely to extend through August when the month is over. Across most of the Hill Country and the Austin area, rainfall since last October is between 16 and 20 inches below normal. Across Central Texas and the middle Texas coast, rainfall is running more than 20 inches below normal.

In light of the severe conditions plaguing the area, Buena Vista Water System must implement MANDATORY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS. Buena Vista Water System is implementing Stage III Mandatory Water Use Restrictions in accord with the Buena Vista Drought Contingency Plan filed with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

Implementing Stage III measures will assist in achieving the goal of a 20 percent reduction in overall water consumption. In addition, successful implementation of water use restrictions may prevent more stringent restrictions if the drought persists.

The following MANDATORY Stage III water use restrictions shall apply to customers effective September 4, 2011 and will remain in effect until further notice.

- Irrigation of landscaped areas with hose-end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems shall be limited to
 one day a week, designated below. Irrigation of landscaped area further limited to the hours of 12:00
 midnight until 10:00 a.m. and between 8:00 p and 12:00 midnight on designated watering days. However,
 irrigation of landscapes areas is permitted at anytime if it is by means of a hand-held hose a faucet filled
 bucket or watering can of five (5) gallon's or less, or drip Irrigation system.
 - Mondays for customers with a street address ending with numbers 1, 2, or 3,
 - Wednesdays for customers with a street address ending with the numbers 4, 5, or 6,
 - Fridays for customers with a street address ending with the numbers 7, 8, 9, or 0.
- 2. Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, airplane or other vehicle is prohibited except on designated watering days between the hours of 12 midnight and 10:00 a.m. and between 8:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight. Such washing, when allowed, shall be done with a hand-held bucket or a hand-held hose equipped w a positive shutoff nozzle for quick rinses. Vehicle washing may be done at any tithe the immediate premises of a commercial car wash or commercial service staff, Further, such washing may be exempted from these regulations if the health, safety and the welfare of the public is contingent frequent vehicle cleansing, such as garbage trucks and vehicles used to transport food and perishables.
- Use of water to fill, refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pools, wading pools, or "jacuzzi" type
 pools is prohibited except on designated watering days between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 a.m.
 and between 8 p.m. and 12:00 midnight.



- Operation of any ornamental fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes prohibited except where necessary to support aquatic fife or where such fountains ponds are equipped with a recirculation system.
- 5. Use of water from hydrants or flush valves shall be limited to maintaining public he safety, and welfare.
- 6. Use of water for the Irrigation of golf courses, parks, and green belt area Is prohibit except by hand held hose and only on designated watering days between the hours.12 midnight and 10:00 a.m. and between 8:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight.
- 7. The following uses of water are defined as non-essential and are prohibited:.
 - Wash down of any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts or other hard surfaced areas;
 - Use of water to wash down buildings or structures for purposes other than immediate fire protection;
 - use of water for dust control;
 - d) flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter or street;
 - failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak(s); and
 - f) Any waste of water.
